

1037 Removal of kinked J tip guide-wire from radial artery

60 years old male attended for routine coronary angiogram to be performed via right radial artery access. After angiography of RCA during exchange of catheters, J tip guide-wire kinked and looped in right radial artery. Different techniques were used for its removal. Right femoral access was used for retrieval. Snare was used from RFA access but unable to reach right radial artery. We used a guide catheter and guide liner to access the J tip wire, a coronary wire was used to pass across the guide wire in catheter from RRA access. Balloon was inflated in guide catheter and was pulled in to descending aorta. A snare was used to pull it from RFA access.
